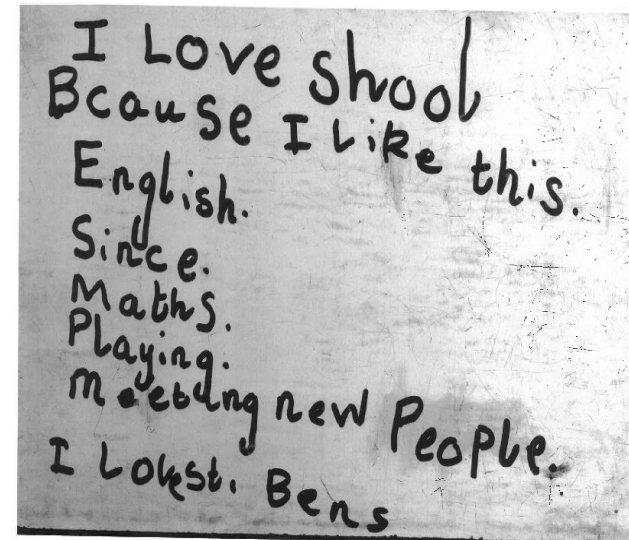
Many thanks also to our staff, who have spent considerable amounts of time in school before the start of term, preparing classrooms and resources.
