This will include weekly 'Gifted &amp; Talented' sessions for older pupils and sports competitions against other schools</p>	<p>£1,200</p>	<p>A wide number of children from across the year groups have attended a number of Sporting events such as cricket, football, cross country, hockey and swimming tournaments against other schools. Gifted and Talented sessions are successfully promoting number of children to achieve sporting excellence.</p>
<p>Sports coaches: The school will fund two specialist sports coaches who will come in and deliver PE to pupils across all age phases weekly. This includes the provision of an after school football club.</p>	<p>£2,860</p>	<p>Two specialist sports coaches visited the school every Friday. The children have benefitted from high quality sporting instruction. School staff have gained valuable insights into the teaching of high quality PE lessons. The children have improved their basic sporting skills and applied them across a range of activities. The after school club has high levels of pupil participation and enjoyment.</p>
<p>Dance Coach. The school will fund a trained dance coach throughout the year The aim is to develop dance and performing arts skills in children from Year 2 –Year 6</p>	<p>£1,500</p>	<p>Autumn-Spring. The children received very high quality dance instruction for a number of weeks. Staff gained valuable insight with the instructor and can now confidently deliver high quality dance lessons in coming years. The linked after school club has high levels of pupil participation and enjoyment.</p>
<p>Transport: The school will fund coaches to transport children to inter-school sports competitions in the area.</p>	<p>£350</p>	<p>The children have accessed a number of sporting events outside of the school locality. No sporting activity has been missed due to the distance required to travel. Children have competed in a range of activities against a number of other schools across North Yorkshire.</p>
<p>Weekly swimming: Children across Key Stages1 and 2 will take part in weekly swimming sessions run by the local sports centre.</p>	<p>£850</p>	<p>Autumn-Spring. Children have made significant progress with their swimming techniques and the distances that they can swim. All children who took part in the swimming sessions increased the distance that they could swim unaided. Records are kept to ensure progress in future years.</p>

<p>Staff to attend CPD courses. This enables teachers to train and lead high standard PE lessons for all children. Cost of supply cover whilst staff are attending courses</p>	<p>£450</p>	<p>Staff attended courses. Ideas fed back to staff and implemented in PE lessons. Staff report positive engagement from children with activities undertaken.</p>
<p>Extra staff to attend sporting activities with children. This enables school to take large numbers/ more than one group of children to compete in local events against other local schools. School to be able to maintain staff: children ratios</p>	<p>£950</p>	<p>A larger number of children, rather than just one small group, have been able to compete in a range of activities against a number of other schools across North Yorkshire.</p>
