Objectives in spending PPG

- To raise attainment of pupils at risk of underachieving in English and Maths by falling below Age Related Expectations
- To provide additional support for those pupils who are at risk of underachieving in English and Maths at the end of the year or the end of the Key Stage

KS2 value added in all subjects was broadly average or above for disadvantaged pupils and those who have special educational needs.

Funds are used to ensure staff support in all classes and for interventions

Targeted CPD for all staff to deliver quality first teaching in reading, writing and maths and to deliver swift interventions.

Funding provided for ICT hardware and software which demonstrates impact on pupil achievement and hardware to give access
